6. TRANSPORT LEVY

At the request of the three constituent members of the Combined Authority an extraordinary urgent meeting of the Combined Authority has been called to discuss the totality of the transport levy, it's distribution across the constituent Unitary Authorities, and the associated award of supported bus contracts.

The requisition submitted by the three Councils requests that the business to be transacted at the extraordinary meeting is as follows.

The Combined Authority will consider the following proposal:

In order to protect essential bus services across the West of England, the Combined Authority Resolves to:

- 1. To consider the feasibility of seeking a one-year extension to the current bus contracts to enable a long term sustainable solution to be found in collaboration with the Unitary Authorities.
- 2. To underwrite, either 1 above, or any new contract award from appropriate budgets, to enable the constituent councils and the combined authority to consider the budget impact for 23/24 onwards, including a clear assessment as to the VFM of routes, equality and service mitigations, and the appropriate share of service and cost across the Combined Authority and Levied Authorities.

Purpose of Report

- 1.1 This meeting is necessary as the delegation to CEO's by the West of England Combined Authority Committee to agree an increase in the levy of Unitary Authorities up to 10% above the existing 2% increase has not resulted in a decision. This meeting has been requested by the Leaders of the Unitary Authorities, following meetings with CEOs, S151 Officers and Infrastructure Directors and/or their representatives. It sets out the key aspects of the Supported Bus Services contract including costs and proposed options for Unitary Authority consideration, and consequential increases in the Transport Levy from 23/24. The 22/23 increase in new contract prices will be covered utilising the overall Transport Levy and all of these numbers will be provided to committee for full transparency.
- 1.2 These services end on 27th August 2022 and this decision is now very urgent in order for bus service operators to continue to provide these much-needed services.

Impact of Covid-19 pandemic

The Combined Authority has actively reviewed its key activities and work programme to reflect changing priorities as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic. Specific issues relating to the Covid-19 situation that impact on or are addressed through this report are as follows:

• Maintenance and enhancement of a comprehensive network of local bus services and modification of it in line with the adopted Bus Strategy will contribute positively to economic recovery and growth, assist residents in seeking employment and support the principles of clean and inclusive growth

Recommendation

Recommendations

The Unitary Authorities to consider and approve, on a regional basis,

a) No additional increase to the approved 2023/24 levy; or

b) An increase of 5% to the approved 2023/24 levy to cover additional contract costs for supported bus services, alongside a 2.5% contribution from the Combined Authority; or

c) An increase of 7.5% to the approved 2023/24 levy to cover additional contract costs for supported bus services, alongside a 2.5% contribution from the Combined Authority; or

d) An increase of 9% to the approved 2023/24 levy to cover additional contract costs for supported bus services, alongside a 2.5% contribution from the Combined Authority

Reasons for recommendation

• This is about maintaining supported bus services in the region for the benefit of our residents and business. Unitary Authorities are asked if and by how much they want to increase their transport levy by over and above the existing 2% increase budgeted for, recognising the balancing of this decision against the significant inflationary, economic, and other service pressures being dealt with.

Voting arrangements

• The decision concerns a levy and will require the unanimous agreement of Committee Members or their substitutes present and voting, excluding the Mayor.

Background / Issues for Consideration

Background and regional approach

- 2.1 Whilst not on a like for like basis, it should be noted and have broad regard to the Transport Levy provided by Unitary Authorities to the Combined Authority being less than 50% of the levy of other comparable Combined Authorities across the country.
- 2.2 The purpose and intention of the integration of the bus service function in 2020 was to properly reflect the powers and responsibilities set out in the legislation establishing the Combined Authority. In doing so it provided the opportunity to bring more consistency and efficiencies to the delivery of functions across the Combined Authority area, including how supported bus services were contracted and managed. There are inevitable limitations to any comparative analysis given the reliance on the detailed costings undertaken by bidders.

- 2.3 All bus service contracts were novated to the Combined Authority in April 2020 and subsequently reviewed and extended where necessary to align expiry dates and enable a collective and consistent approach to be taken to the procurement of the next set of contracts. This has enabled us to secure improved value for money as operators have been able to optimise the utilisation of their vehicles, saving on operational costs.
- 2.4 The other advantage of bringing together the management of bus services is providing greater consistency across the Local Transport Authority. This includes in the evaluation of contract tender prices, for example to ensure as far as possible, services supported do not have wildly different costs per passenger journey.
- 2.5 This is a particularly challenging time in the economy with inflation (CPI) at 9% having increased from 5.5% in January. CPI is forecast to end this calendar year at nearer 10%. It is then broadly forecast to reduce to some 3% to 4% by December 2023. The budgets for the 2023 Transport Levy were increased by 2%. This is insufficient to maintain services on a like for like basis. Funding all services requires an 11.5% increase in year one above the 2% already provided for. Thereafter, inflation is capped. This is largely the crystallisation of the lower than necessary inflation allowance being budgeted for.
- 2.6 A number of these services do require significant subsidies per person on a transport journey. Examples of this are shown in the report with the full analysis shown in the attached appendices.
- 2.7 The Transport levy includes several service areas including for example concessionary fares. This report is about the supported bus services element of the transport levy. Other areas will be reviewed later in the year when appropriate. The 43% Bus Services increase equates to an 11.5% increase in the overall transport levy.
- 2.8 Officers have looked at the option of endeavouring to extend the existing supported services contracts by a period such as 1 year. Indicative increases of 58% for supported bus services for a one-year period are indicated from contractors and exceed the 43% increase in supported services. This translates to an additional 15% premium for extending contracts, rather than contract at this point in time (a minimum potential total additional increase of c. £1 million above the costs already included in this report). The issue is whether this is a worse time to contract rather than in a year's time. There is a very real possibility of stagflation (worsening economy growth and increasing inflation concurrently) and there is no certainty that a relet in a year's time will result in a better position financially. Inflationary increases from this year will be built into the base contract that would start in a year's' time. This option is a judgement call based on current information and forecasts with significant risks should it go wrong through a worsening economic position. It is worth

noting the current contract does include some protection against future years increases as already set out in this report.

Supported bus services

- 2.9 The Combined Authority has provided support to 80 bus service contracts around the region which were not viable as commercial operations prior to the onset of the pandemic. These contracts come to an end on 27 August and the Combined Authority has recently carried out a re-tendering exercise for new contracts to start from 28 August. The Combined Authority Committee on 28 January agreed that a procurement process be initiated, and that authority be delegated to the Head of Strategic Transport Integration (now Head of Integrated Transport Operations), in consultation with relevant Members of the Transport Board, to award new local bus service contracts.
- 2.10 The timeframe for the award of new contracts is set out in the table below. This ensures that there is no loss of service between contracts. These dates do come with some risk; for example, if a bus operator does not accept a contract award, then this will be put to next bidder on the list requiring another 10 days for the standstill period to end. Once an operator accepts the contracts and the standstill period ends there is reduced time for that bus operator to prepare their resources to get the bus service registered/start service operation. A full timeline on the procurement process was provided in Appendix B in 28th January 2022 Committee Report and a summary is in the table below:

- 2.11 The recent tender exercise resulted in a 43% increase in like-for-like tender prices, an increase of around £2m p.a. in contract costs. This increase creates a significant pressure on the available budget for Supporting Bus Services, prompting the consideration of the Transport Levy and the recommendation to the 8 April Committee for an increase in the levy of up to 10% (approximately £2m p.a.).
- 2.12 In the light of the 8 April Committee decision, the Supported Bus Service tender evaluation concentrated on the services that could continue with a 10% equivalent increase in the levy. Officers looked at options available to support bus services based on Cost Per Passenger Journey (cppj) and the Evaluation Framework (setting out our combined priorities for supporting bus services as set out in our Bus Strategy). This information was discussed with lead Transport Members and officers and the proposed option put forward was based on not supporting any services with a cppj of £40 or higher: this can be found in Appendix 3.
- 2.13 On request, an additional option has been developed for a +5% equivalent funding scenario and for no increase, i.e. at Medium Term Financial Plan MTFP level. These can be found in Appendices 1 and 2 which set out the service consequences of these lower levels of funding.

Bus Service Improvement Plan

2.14 The DfT recently announced indicative funding awards for Bus Service Improvement Plans. The West of England BSIP (jointly submitted by the Combined Authority and North Somerset Council) was given an indicative allocation of £105.5m (£48m capital, £57.5m revenue) to improve the bus network across the wider West of England region. This award (the second highest in the country) will provide an unprecedented opportunity to create a 'step change' in the public transport offer by identifying new routes right across the region, including consideration of mitigating service impacts and meeting the transport needs of many communities in the area. This will, over time, bolster the public transport network with enhanced service frequencies on both commercial and supported routes, kick-start new services that should eventually become commercial, and introduce demand responsive transport where conventional supported services are not appropriate or feasible. This will both complement and expand the existing bus network and is expected to lead to a growth in passenger numbers. There will be a report to the July Combined Authority Committee setting out the significant investment in Bus services for the benefit of our residents and business.

Consultation

3.1 As part of the review, we carried out a passenger survey on all existing supported bus services. This was designed to invite comments on the performance of these services and provide complementary information on

journey purpose, time of travel, what alternatives people had to using the bus, suggested improvements etc. However, the survey was specifically not to provide a 'count' of users and therefore will not be used to justify any decision as to whether to continue to support a particular service based on usage alone – although we do have usage data for supported services provided separately by operators. The survey generated over 1500 responses of which over 80% were from users of these supported services.

3.2 Officers have met with Transport Board Members and CEO's to discuss the increase in the Transport Levy.

Risk Management/Assessment

4 A risk assessment of various options has been undertaken and been shared with the Unitary Authority and Combined Authority officers on a confidential basis as appropriate.

Public Sector Equality Duties

- 5 The public sector equality duty created under the Equality Act 2010 means that public authorities must have due regard to the need to:
 - Eliminate unlawful discrimination, harassment and victimization and other conduct prohibited by the Act.
 - Advance equality of opportunity between people who share a protected characteristic and those who do not.
 - Foster good relations between people who share a protected characteristic and those who do not.
- 5.1 The Act explains that having due regard for advancing equality involves:
 - Removing or minimising disadvantages suffered by people due to their protected characteristics.
 - Taking steps to meet the needs of people from protected groups where these are different from the needs of other people.
 - Encouraging people from protected groups to participate in public life or in other activities where their participation is disproportionately low.
- 5.2 The general equality duty therefore requires organisations to consider how they could positively contribute to the advancement of equality and good relations. It requires equality considerations to be reflected in the design of policies and the delivery of services, including policies, and for these issues to be kept under review.
- 5.3 A comprehensive, accessible and affordable bus network is vital to enabling people to access jobs, health, food, leisure and other services and opportunities. When officers are carrying out a review of the network provision

as part of the DfT network review they will ensure that we utilise BSIP funding to minimise any impacts on residents. The mitigations proposed in this report aim to maintain and improve the vast majority of bus services across the region. However, this is dependent on available funding for bus services. These mitigations will help meet the Combined Authorities obligations under the Equality Act.

Finance Implications, including economic impact assessment where appropriate:

6.1 There are financial implications in the main body of this report. The Transport Levy is made up of funds from the 3 constituent authorities (B&NES, BCC & SGC). The budget available for supported bus services is made up from an element from the levy (£3.085m in 22/23) plus Bus Service Operator Grant from the DfT. This is enhanced by any appropriate S106 funding. The below table provides a breakdown by UA:

*The balance of supported bus services is funded through Bus Service Operator Grant from the DfT and managing the overall Transport Levy. **22/23 has not been shown as the additional costs will be managed through the overall Transport Levy.

- 6.2 The 43% increase in like-for-like supported bus contracts reflects the increased inflationary costs which bus operators are incurring, especially driver costs, which account for approximately 45% of the operation cost of a service. The MTFF currently makes provision for an annual 2% increase in the Transport Levy from 2023/24 which aligns with the inflation provisions within the contracts, once let, which have a +2% cap. The recommended increase in the Transport Levy would therefore result in a net additional 12% more money for supported services in the region based on current levels.
- 6.3 Inflation Provision within the contract:
 - The price revision will be based on the changes to the Consumer price Index (CPI) as published in the November edition of the Monthly Digest of Statistics. Please note that this could result in contract prices going down.

- The percentage change in price will be based on the movement of prices between October of the previous year and October of the current year. (e.g. for the first review it will be the price change % between October 2021 and October 2022).
- The Percentage change in price will also be capped at + or 2%. Please note this may be subject to review.
- 6.4 The below table sets out the implications of various funding alternatives in terms of number of services that would be lost compared with the current contracts.

Option D will mean the levy is supporting the 4 bus services which do not offer value for money, with their cost per passenger journey ranging from £41.49 to £213.27.

6.5 In agreement with the UA S151 officers, the Combined Authority has created a smoothing reserve to manage any fluctuations in in-year costs within the transport operations area. This is funding which can only be used once in order to step in and provide short notice assistance to a service at risk. The current smoothing reserve stands at £616k and would equate to £123k support per year towards a 5-year contract. Committing the smoothing reserve would remove the ability for the Combined Authority to step in and "rescue" a service should that be necessary. Given the current uncertainties around service provision due to driver availability and other costs, this would be a significant risk.

Combined Authority Contribution

- 6.6 The Combined Authority has looked for ways to contribute towards the additional costs of providing these services and this significant contribution is included within this report.
- 6.7 Note that Combined Authority officers will continue to work with the bus operators to drive efficiencies in costs for the appropriate benefit of all parties and review other aspects of the transport levy e.g. concessionary fares, when

information becomes available to do so.

Operational Efficiencies

- 6.8 Efficiencies are already built-in to the tender prices received from bus operators and are explained as follows:
 - The creation of the Transport Operations Team involving the integration of supported bus service contracts from April 2020 has allowed the alignment of all contract end dates to get best value for money for the authorities.
 - Contract alignment ensures that all supported bus services are considered consistently, objectively and at a regional level.
 - All contracts have therefore been reviewed at the same time and no services are looked at in isolation.
 - As part of the recent tender exercise, group prices were requested for services (this is so that operators are able to utilise their vehicle resource over more than one service rather than individually).
 - This has allowed savings of £438k to be made against individual route prices. Some examples of this are provided below:

Alternative funding sources within the Combined Authority

- 6.9 The Combined Authority has considered appropriate funding options available to it within the timescales available, ensuring the appropriate risk management considerations are made. Any investments in this service area will need to fully meet the normal considerations against externally set and/or the Combined Authority Committee approved criteria as appropriate.
- 6.10 In overall terms it is therefore considered acceptable for a contribution to be made to supported bus services from the Combined Authority and a sum of £500k is recommended to significantly invest and reduce the burden of the increase in the Transport Levy on the UAs for this purpose. It remains however, subject to some risk, as follows:
 - Funding will not be absolutely confirmed until the summer
 - The anticipated funding is for three years only meaning additional funding/Levy increase would be required from 2025/26 for contracts to continue (decision on this by summer 2024). It buys time to resolve this future pressure.
 - Services supported through funding need to have been justifiable and meet the relevant criteria requirements.
 - The funding decisions will need to involve appropriate partners.
 - Note that should the Combined Authority funding not be appropriate for use that the Unitary Authorities will make good the resultant funding gap.
