<b>Decision Title:</b> Low Carbon Challenge Fund - Green Business Grants

<p><b>Background / reason for decision:</b></p> <p>Delegated authority has been granted to the Combined Authority's Chief Executive to take decisions on the award of Green Business Grants (through the Low Carbon Challenge Fund) in consultation with the Chief Executives of the West of England unitary authorities.</p> <p>Green Business grant applications were submitted as follows:</p> <p>Green Business grant applicant: Pullins (Bakers) Ltd Sector: Manufacturing Local authority area: North Somerset Project timescale: 21 days (delayed start)</p> <p>Green Business grant applicant: Nanona Ltd Sector: Accommodation and food service Local authority area: North Somerset Project timescale: 2 Months</p> <p>Green Business grant applicant: Nameless Media Group Ltd Sector: Business and domestic software development Local authority area: Bristol City Project timescale: 20 days</p> <p>The above applications were assessed by officers as meeting the required criteria in terms of value for money, deliverability and financial viability.</p> <p>The Chief Executives of the West of England unitary authorities were consulted on these proposals and were in agreement with the decision.</p>

<b>Decision:</b>

1. To award £15,000 to Pullins (Bakers) Ltd in relation to their Green Business Grant application (ref: GBG129) for Solar PV.

2. To award £3,719.24 to Nanona Ltd in relation to their Green Business Grant application (ref: GBG143) for Double glazing & LED lighting.

3. To award £15,000 to Nameless Media Group Ltd in relation to their Green Business Grant application (ref: GBG167) for Air-to-water heat pump.
