Background / reason for decision:

Delegated authority has been granted to the Combined Authority's Chief Executive to take decisions on the award of the Innovative Local Energy Scheme (through the Low Carbon Challenge Fund) in consultation with the Chief Executives of the West of England unitary authorities.
