**Decision Title:** Low Carbon Business Support – Green Business Grants and Solar Roof Grants

#### Decision Taken

That £66k of grant is awarded to 6 applicants. If all are awarded, this will leave:

- £1.83m remaining of the £2.0m total Green Business Grants pot to allocate
- £459k remaining of the £500k total Rooftop Solar Grants pot to allocate
