Reasons for the Decision

The grants will meet the eligibility requirements of the Fund and will achieve the objectives of the Fund to support small cultural and community events to grow and become more impactful in terms of three possible outcomes:

- a. Increased participation and volunteering from within the community or place, in organising and delivering the event.
- b. Improved cohesion amongst communities and places where new development or regeneration has taken place.
- c. Encouraging local communities and others back to high streets, town centres or community hubs.
