

## **Decision Notice**

**Decision Title:** Regional Low Carbon Delivery Change Request

**Decision Date:** 8th November 2023

## **Decision Taken**

That:

1) CEOs support the proposed extension to the Regional Low Carbon Delivery Full Business Case. This applies an additional £716,000, allocated at March 2023 committee, to the £4.9m Full Business Case, enabling the extension of the free carbon survey offer.

## **Reasons for the Decision**

- 1. An outline funding proposal was approved at the West of England Combined Authority Committee in March 2023 to expand the Mayoral Combined Authority (MCA) Carbon Survey offer.
- 2. Annex A CEO RLCD Change Request sets out in detail how this funding will increase the number of carbon surveys by 450 and expand the range of businesses engaged in the scheme.
- 3. The Combined Authority will work closely with the Local Authority Economic Development teams to promote the offer in priority areas.
